

This month's Patch Tuesday includes several critical updates that address vulnerabilities targeting end users, all of which should be considered top priorities. Both Adobe and Microsoft also released critical updates for Flash Player.

September 2016 will be the final Patch Tuesday on the old servicing model. Starting in October, Microsoft has announced a change to the servicing models for all pre-Windows 10 operating systems.
