













After several months with no zero day disclosures, October Patch Tuesday brings updates for four vulnerabilities already exploited in the wild.
Beginning this month, Microsoft and Adobe are also changing how they distribute their updates, which may impact how you can access the patches. Finally, we are expecting a Google Chrome release today and Oracle's Quarterly CPU next week, so plan on updates for Java JRE and many other Oracle solutions.
