May Patch Tuesday resolves five actively exploited and two publicly disclosed vulnerabilities. Spoiler alert: all five zero-days are resolved by deploying the Windows OS update. Also, this month Windows 11 and Server 2025 updates include some new Al features, but they carry a lot of baggage. Literally - they are around 4GB! New Al features include Recall, Click to Do and Improved Windows Search.

Rounding out Patch Tuesday on the third-party side we have a number of Adobe Creative Suite updates, and keep an eye out for the weekly Google Chrome update.
